

Instruction of the Dean of the Faculty of Science of Masaryk University

**No. 2/2024 on the Implementation of
Masaryk University Measure No. 5/2023**

(effective as of September 1st, 2024)

In accordance with § 28 par. 1 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Modification and Amendment of Other Acts (Higher Education Act), as later amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), I hereby issue this Instruction:

I.

1. This Instruction regulates the application of Article 1, paragraph 3 of Masaryk University Measure No. 5/2023 regarding the minimum amount of the scholarship to support study in the doctoral study programme in the year 2024.
2. This Instruction applies to students in full-time doctoral study programmes at the Faculty of Science of Masaryk University who enrolled before June 1, 2024, and who have been granted a scholarship to support their study in a doctoral study programme under Article 6, paragraph 1 of the MU scholarship and bursary regulations, until the end of the month in which the standard length of study is exceeded, accounting for all periods of previous unsuccessful doctoral studies, while the relevant measure of the Rector of Masaryk University determines the scholarship amount.
3. If a student, as per the previous paragraph, receives a net monthly salary for activities related to their doctoral study as part of an employment relationship with Masaryk University, or other scholarships provided to support their full-time doctoral study, the provisions of Article 1, paragraph 3 of Masaryk University Measure No. 5/2023 shall apply to said student.
4. The amount specified in the first sentence of Article 1, paragraph 3 of Masaryk University Measure No. 5/2023 for the students as mentioned above shall not fall below 15,000 CZK between September 1, 2024, and December 31, 2024. The total guaranteed income of the student shall not fall below 16,000 CZK.

II.

Final Provisions

1. The guaranteed income of the student is the sum of the net monthly salary the student receives for activities related to their doctoral study as part of an employment relationship with Masaryk University and the scholarships provided to support their full-time doctoral study.
2. The interpretation of the individual provisions of this Instruction is assigned to the head of the department responsible for the doctoral study agenda.
3. The compliance with this Instruction shall be inspected by the Vice-Dean for doctoral study authorized under the Organizational Regulations of the Faculty of Science.
4. This Instruction comes into effect on the day of its signature.
5. This Instruction becomes effective on September 1, 2024.
